## CLEVER FUNGUS



### Horse Thrush Care

The mycoparasitic mode of operation and the enzymatic activity of *Pythium oligandrum*, so-called Clever Fungus, eliminate the fungi and bacteria causing thrush efficiently and safely. The hoof becomes drier right after the first application and the natural protective barrier is restored. The growth of new healthy hoof tissue ensues.

While Ecosin is highly effective in the fight against thrush, it treats the hoof tissue gently. The biopreparation is safe to use for all animals as it doesn't contain any chemical agents commonly used in other commercial products. Clever Fungus Ecosin doesn't dry out the affected area, is not caustic or toxic and does not slow the healing and growth of new hoof tissue. Furthermore the biopreparation is effective even in chronic and severe cases of hoof thrush, where the infection is deeply rotted in the tissue.

#### Remember:

Do not use any other antifungal treatments in conjunction with Ecosin at least 5 days prior and 5 days post treatment.

Once mixed with water, the solution must be used within 24 hours.

#### Instructions for use:



1. Dissolve 1 effervescent tablet in two liters of lukewarm water (about 34 °C) and leave it to activate for 20 to 30 minutes. Now go get the horse.



**2.** Using your hoof pick and/or hoof brush, remove all debris, manure and mud from the affected hoof.



**3.** Stir the solution and dip a piece of cotton wool or a clean cloth.



**4.** Apply directly to the affected area and secure by wrapping the hoof.



**5.** Leave the hoof wrapped for 20-30 minutes.

**6.** After removing the wrap allow the hoof to dry naturally. Keep the horse in a dry and clean space immediately after the application (in a clean box stall).

**7.** Repeat all the above steps three times over the course of a week (for example Mon-Wed-Fri pattern). Repeat application the following week if necessary. It's not caustic or toxic so there's no danger in overusing the procedure.
